

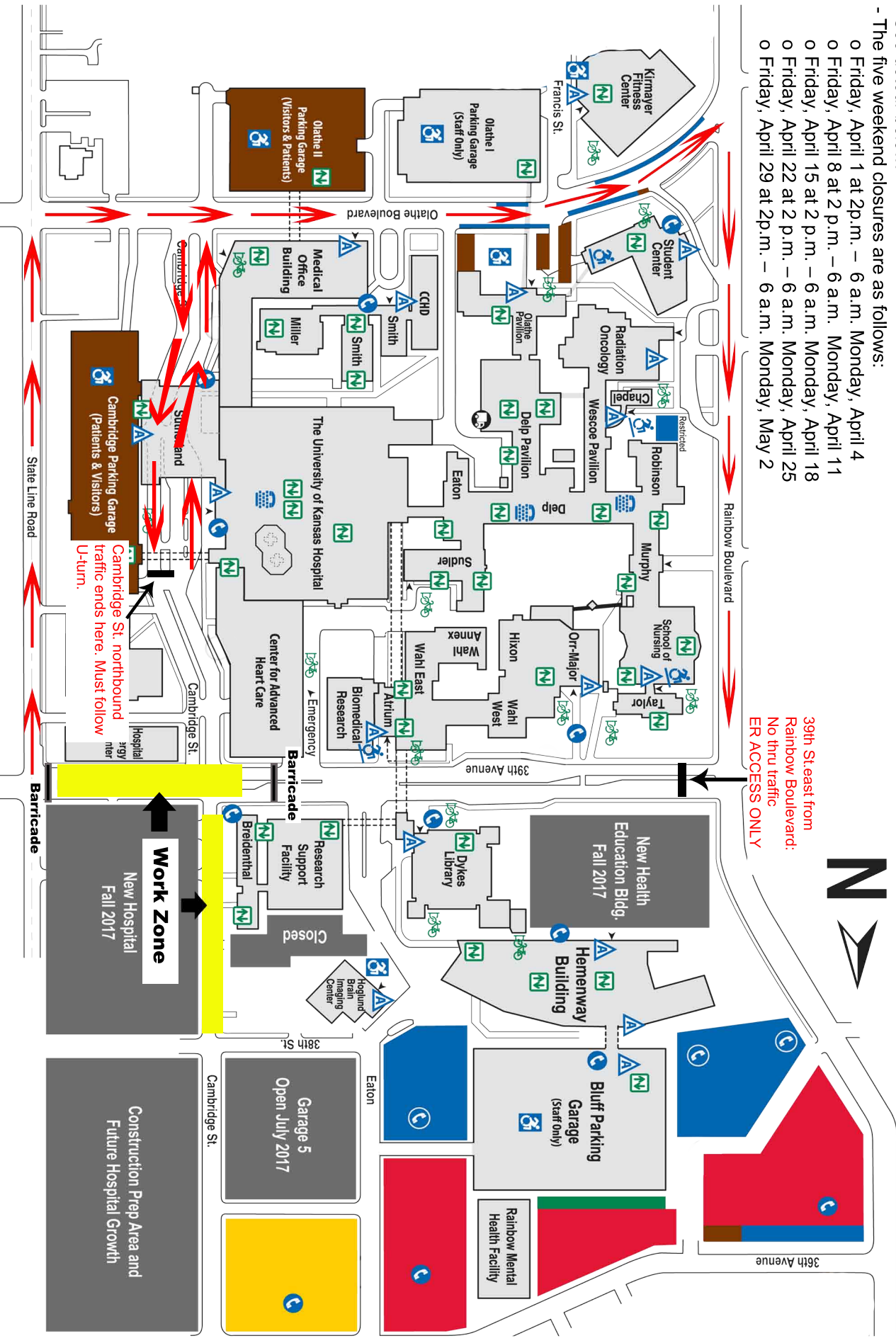
Cambridge North Tower/Health Education Building Weekend Closure Detour Map

As part of The University of Kansas Hospital's Cambridge North Tower project, approximately five weekend closures will be necessary to install the pedestrian bridge that will connect the new tower to the Center for Advanced Heart Care.

-The closure will include a complete shutdown on 39th St. from Cambridge St. to State Line. including access to the front of the hospital on Cambridge from 39th St. Emergency Room (ER) access from Rainbow Boulevard will not be impacted. ER traffic from the east will be detoured from State Line, to Olathe Boulevard, to Rainbow Boulevard back to 39th St. See detour below.

-The five weekend closures are as follows:

- o Friday, April 1 at 2p.m. – 6 a.m. Monday, April 4
- o Friday, April 8 at 2 p.m. – 6 a.m. Monday, April 11
- o Friday, April 15 at 2 p.m. – 6 a.m. Monday, April 18
- o Friday, April 22 at 2 p.m. – 6 a.m. Monday, April 25
- o Friday, April 29 at 2p.m. – 6 a.m. Monday, May 2
